i. The omnibus contains a 0.189% across-the board rescission to all programs in the Labor-HHS-Education Section (except for Pell grants). This cut applies to FY 12 appropriations. Because four programs (Title I, IDEA Part B Grants to States, WIA and Career and Technical Education State grants) include both FY 12 appropriations and advanced FY 13 appropriations contained in this bill, the 0.189% cut only applies to the FY 12 funding, not the advanced FY 13 appropriations.

ii. The 0.189% cut applies to FY 12 advanced appropriations for these four programs provided in the FY 11 continuing resolution. That cut is included in the FY 11 total in this chart, since it affects funds for the 2011-12 school year.
